At a closed session of the Plenum on 21 April 2021, the Constitutional Court of the Slovak Republic ruled:

Case PL. ÚS 24/2019

The Constitutional Court decided on the motion of a group of members of the Parliament pursuant to Art. 125 par. 1 a) of the Constitution of the Slovak Republic on the compliance of the notion “first instance” in Sec. 24 par. 2 b) and of the notion “I. degree” in Sec. 24 par. 4 of Law No. 245/2008 on upbringing and education (School Act), as amended, with the Constitution of the Slovak Republic, the Convention on the Rights of the Child and the Convention for the Protection of Human Rights and Fundamental Freedoms.
